



Tottenham Artisan Market (TAM)

Tottenham Artisan Market (TAM) as used herein refers to the Beeton Tottenham Business Improvement Association (BTBIA) and its employees, directors, agents and volunteers

The TAM is overseen by a board of directors. The Board has adopted the following rules and regulations. At times the board may amend, delete or modify its policies, rules and regulations in order to promote the TAM as a whole to the community of Tottenham. All vendors in the TAM will behave toward the TAM customers, Board Staff, Board Directors and volunteers in a professional manner which fosters a sense of community, health, family, camaraderie and a spirit of cooperative involvement.

Terms and Conditions

1. Vendors agree to provide all of their own equipment, including tables, chairs, booths, trailers, and/or tents.
2. The TAM organizers reserve the right to restrict the type and number of vendor concessions. Applicants with full advance payment are given first consideration. The vendors will advise in writing if they require any special needs or requests.
3. Vendors may only sell those products listed on the TAM application form. TAM reserves the right to enforce the vendor's product list. Failure to comply will result in vendor being asked to vacate the premise, forfeit all fees and future eligibility to TAM and future BTBIA events.
4. Setup: Vendors may begin installation of vendor booths by 8am. All vendors must be fully operational by 9:15am
Tear Down: For the safety of all concerned vendors must not dismantle and/or remove their vendor booth before 1:30pm and prior to 3:00pm
5. Vendors are responsible for leaving the area in a neat and tidy condition, failure to comply will result in ineligibility for future attendance in market day and other BTBIA events
6. The TAM organizers reserve the right to assign the vendor to designated areas and occupancy and use shall be confined to the designated area.
7. Have all electrical equipment pre approved by TAM
8. Vendors with prepared food must follow the Simcoe County Health Unit Regulations
9. Vendors selling / cooking food must follow the Simcoe County Health Unit Regulations
